



FASD monitoring of all these buildings provides a minute to minute account of all OPEN and CLOSE actions on all doors.

This includes the complex fire alarm design of the \$8.4 million Atrium project and the actual installation and acceptance testing of the system. FASD recently completed the redesign and installation of a new fire alarm and CCTV/security system at their Sachem Street Campus and additional off campus buildings.

Windham Hospital has been serving Connecticut for nearly 80 years. When the time came to expand and add a medical office building they came to FASD to not only design the integrated fire alarm, security, Mass notification and CCTV system but be sole source provider for devices and be the vendor to program and bring the system online. FASD knew what would be needed to work with the existing systems already being serviced 24/7 and semi annually tested and inspected by FASD. We are in the process of installing a complex security, card access and CCTV system in the new MOB building very similar to the system we service in the Main Hospital.

Like other hospitals they also have many clinics and satellite offices that require the same level of fire and security protection. FASD provides that by adding a solid security system to work in-hand with the fire alarm system to clinics like the Women's Health Center in Mansfield.

WINDHAM HIGH SCHOOL

We recently installed an IP camera system with over 60 cameras that included 3 digital video recorders (1 hybrid and 2 network), indoor and outdoor dome cameras, outdoor PTZ cameras and LCD TV monitors. We have acquired the responsibility for the annual testing and inspecting of fire alarm systems at all of the Windham Public Schools.

WINDHAM MIDDLE SCHOOL

We are in the process of designing and implementing a security camera system, as well as all of the CCTV broadcast system.

We have repaired and updated their radio master box network to ensure the communication between the schools and the Fire/police department is seamless and no additional phone call needed once the alarm is sounding.

CHARLES H BARROWS (STEM MAGNET SCHOOL)

Charles H. Barrows STEM Academy is a new, regional magnet school in northeastern Connecticut operated by Windham Public Schools and is the first Kindergarten through 8th grade magnet school in the region. STEM is an acronym for Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics. Focusing on these subjects will help students gain important cognitive and academic skill, enhancing their ability to think critically, solve complex problems and work collaboratively. The state-of-the-art, 83,700-sq.-ft school is sited on a sheltering hillside to take full advantage of solar energy.

We have installed indoor and outdoor dome cameras, outdoor PTZ cameras and IP cameras all with monitoring capabilities. We have the responsibility for the annual testing and inspecting of fire alarm systems and all fire extinguishers on all properties.

DMHAS operates on the belief that most people with mental illnesses and/or substance use disorders can and should be treated in community settings, and that inpatient treatment should be used only when absolutely necessary to meet the best interests of the patient. Effective care requires that services such as residential, supportive, rehabilitative and crisis intervention programs are available within their local communities. DMHAS is responsible for providing a wide range of services to adults in each of the five human service regions in Connecticut.

FASD was originally hired to simply test the fire dampers. When the fire alarm system failed at the Blue Hills Hospital in late-2011, it was us they called to rebuild the system. Short on time and funds they needed us to design and install a cost-effective system that reused as many devices as possible and would communicate with their radio box monitoring. We now provide 24/7 service and semi-annual testing of the fire alarms and radio boxes at 2 locations in Hartford. We also have a state wide contract so we are able to help out many other State Agencies.

The William W. Backus Hospital is a leading health care institution, providing a network of services for the Hartford Healthcare of Eastern Connecticut. Their network not only includes their main hospital in Norwich, CT but several medical centers. Backus rents some spaces in a part of a complex with a facility management company, all of these locations receive FASD's 24/7 service. Coordinating semi-annual testing and inspecting of fire alarm systems with Backus Hospital and all of the Backus Medical Office Buildings, including their new Norwich and Plainfield Emergency Centers, offsite warehouse and many health clinics can be a time consuming task but is no problem for FASD'S team of office staff. On a monthly basis emergency lights and exits and fire extinguisher are checked at the hospital and all of the health clinics and warehouse. All of these locations are closely monitored and report to the main hospitals switchboard.

Mystic Aquarium & Institute for Exploration is one of the nation's leading aquariums and home of famed ocean explorer Dr. Robert Ballard and his Institute for Exploration. Mystic Aquarium is an aquarium and oceanography institute in Mystic, Connecticut. It is part of the Sea Research Foundation, a nonprofit organization that also includes JASON Learning and the Ocean Exploration Center. The Aquarium is one of three U.S. facilities holding Steller sea lions and it has one of the largest outdoor Beluga whale exhibits in the United States. Special exhibits include a ray and shark touch pool, a penguin exhibit, and a jelly gallery. The Ocean

Exploration Center features maps, diagrams, and models from Dr. Robert Ballard's explorations of the Black Sea and of the wreck of the RMS *Titanic*. At the Nautilus Live Theater, presentations tell more of Dr. Ballard's more recent explorations and the ship E/V Nautilus. Audience members have a live link to crew members on the ship at sea and can ask them questions directly.

The Aquarium needed a complete access control and employee photo-badge system that could be accessed using printable non-magnetic-strip key cards. There was nothing in place for either badges or electronic access at the time. Being a non-profit it needed to be cost effective to install and easy to manage and maintain by current personnel. The system that FASD designed and installed has now been in place and fully functional for almost 2 years. Other than ordering new cards every few months The Aquarium has a system that allows and disallows access to over 50 doors (located both indoors and outdoors) and hundreds of employees, volunteers and vendors. Badge printing and access control are managed by the in-house Maintenance staff from their desktops. We have integrated a CCTV system with their access control and security systems.

We have currently installed the Alertus a mass notification system that will alert everyone in the building via text, desktop capture or beacon in the case of an emergency or a select group of people dedicated to rescuing a stranded animal.
